THE WORD THIS WEEK

Today's Gospel follows the story of the Road to Emmaus. It is another account of the events of last week's Gospel; we are still on the day of the Resurrection and the two Emmaus disciples, after recognising Jesus, had set out 'that instant' to tell the others what they had seen. Suddenly Jesus appears among them which initially produces alarm, but Jesus makes the gesture to all of them which he only made to Thomas in John's account - *look at my hands and feet... touch for yourselves.* He then eats with them to prove that he is not a ghost.
