The Word This Week

The exuberant first reading today connects with the gospel in the middle of the passage, with the words 'Now towards her I send flowing peace, like a river.' The whole passage is about the solace that we get from the Lord, and how our heart rejoices at the sight. The Psalm reflects our reaction to this. The Gospel finally shows how the bringing of peace causes rejoicing. The second reading opens with the introit of Maundy Thursday, 'The only thing I can boast about is the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ'. They could be used by ourselves if we are 'sent out' to preach
